Will of William In the name of God Amen I William Esq of Peace and Justice of the County of Washington in the County of Washington do hereby certify that I am of perfect mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality of my body give cause and desire that my estate in the following manner and form (viz) I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Margaret Esq the house that I now live in with all the household furniture and kitchen utensils my more or less for the support her body and my two Gardens the Meadows and Sugar Camp the Rent of my Plantation on Spring Creek adjoining my son Nicholas and fifty five pounds in money during her Natural life also Frederick Esq to cut and hew out and hew in her hay and carry the grain to and from the mill when ground a sufficient quantity yearly and every year during her Natural life and at her death the kitchen utensils household furniture is to descend to my heirs, also John and Bequest Esq to my son Henry Esq the sum of five pounds, also John and Bequest Esq to Andrew Esq one hundred and seven acres of land where he now lives on and sixteen pounds in money also John and Bequest to my son David Esq one hundred and seven acres of land where he now lives on and thirty three pounds in money also John and Bequest to my son Nicholas Esq one hundred and eighty seven acres of land where he now lives on subject to a payment of forty three pounds to be paid to my executor for the use of my heirs the above property of Land is to be paid to my executor and to my daughter Abigail and her husband George Willhelm one hundred and seven acres of land where they now live on subject to a payment of fifty pounds to be paid to my executor for the use of my heirs, and the above estate of Land with all the buildings heretofore and hereafter to be made by Abigail and George Willhelm one hundred and seven acres of land where they now live on and thirty three pounds in money also John and Bequest to my daughter Abigail and her husband Frederick Esq the sum of eighty pounds and one third that share of said wharf of one hundred and thirty pounds for the Service that he is to render my wife after my death and I do hereby authorize my Executor to execute a Deed of conveyance in fee simple to said Frederick Esq for one hundred and seven acres of land where he now lives on and to my wife during her life also it is my will and I do order that the one half of all the Interest in the said Frederick Esq lands at my death be given to the said Abigail Esq and Bequest to my daughter Margaret Esq otherwise I bequeath the sum of five hundred
